

HEALTHY AT STUDIO GUIDELINES

As far as safety concerns and precautions... these guidelines must be met.

- ◆ One entrance (the back door at the top of the black stairway) and one exit (the front door next to Brownsboro Hardware). For the younger students, parents will be allowed to walk the children up the stairway but will have to promptly exit down the front stairs, after answering the health screening questions.
- ◆ A temperature and Health Screening Questionnaire will be done and recorded before every class.
- ◆ There will be a mandatory 14-day quarantine from LAFA classes for students traveling to a state reporting a positive rate equal or greater than 15% of Covid-19 testing. The states are: AL, FL, ID, SC, AZ, GA, NA, MS (8-4-2020)
- ◆ All classes are set up with a Zoom option in order to accommodate those students not ready to come back, to maintain social distancing for some rehearsals, and to ensure students that become exposed to the virus have a safe place to not miss a lesson.
- ◆ All children under the age of 10 will be walked down by a faculty member. All children 10 and over will be sent down spaced apart, but in groups.
- ◆ All students (5 and older) and faculty will be required to wear a mask at all times. This includes the parents/guardians if they are coming up the stairs.

- ◆ Restrooms will be wiped down between each student
- ◆ Studios will be wiped down in between each class.
- ◆ Students and teachers are asked to bring their own water bottles pre-filled.
- ◆ Hand sanitizer will be available in each classroom.
- ◆ Students need to come pre-dressed in their dance clothes with their hair done. Please make sure you are covered (top and bottom) when entering/exiting the building.
